

Arbitration Act, 1940 [Repealed]

Section 1 - Short Title, Extent and Commencement

- (1) This Act may be called the Arbitration act, 1940.
- (2) It extends¹to the whole of India²[except the State of Jammu and Kashmir.]
- (3) It shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1940.
