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Arbitration Act, 1940 [Repealed]

Section 42 - Service of Notice by Party or Arbitrator

Any notice required by this Act to be served otherwise than through the Court by a part to an arbitration agreement or by an arbitrator or umpire shall be served in the manner provided in the arbitration agreement, or if there is no such provision, either -

(a) by delivering it to the person on whom it is to be served, or

(b) by sending it by post in a letter addressed to that person at his usual or last known place of abode or business in¹[India] and registered under Chapter VI of the Indian Post Office Act, 1898 (6 of 1898).
