

Prisons Act, 1894

Section 6 - Officers of Prisons

For every prison there shall be a Superintendent, a Medical Officer (who may also be the Superintendent), a Medical Subordinate, a Jailer and such other officers as the State Government thinks necessary:

Provided that ¹ [the ² [State Government of Bombay]] may ³ [* * *] declare by order in writing that in any prison specified in the order the office of Jailer shall be held by the person appointed to the Superintendent.
