

Information Technology Act, 2000

Section 30 - Certifying Authority to Follow Certain Procedures

Every Certifying Authority shall,—

- (a) make use of hardware, software, and procedures that are secure from intrusion and misuse;
- (b) provide a reasonable level of reliability in its services which are reasonably suited to the performance of intended functions;
- (c) adhere to security procedures to ensure that the secrecy and privacy of the ¹[Electronic] signatures are ²[***]; and ³[(ca) be the repository of all Electronic Signature Certificates issued under this Act;
- (cb) publish information regarding its practices, Electronic Signature Certificates and current status of such certificates; and".]
- (d) observe such other standards as may be specified by regulations.
