**Information Technology (Amendment) Act 2008**

**Section 66C - Whoever, fraudulently or dishonestly make use of the electronic signature, for identity**

66C. Whoever dishonestly receives or retains an stolen computer resource or communication device knowing or having reason to believe the same to be stolen computer resource or communication device, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years or with fine which may extend to rupees one lakh or with both. Whoever fraudulently or dishonestly makes use of the electronic signature or any other unique identification feature of any other person, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to rupees one lakh.
