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THE BIHAR IRRIGATION ACT, 1997

To provide for and consolidate the law relating to irrigation embankment, drainage, levy and assessment of water rates, betterment contribution and matter connected therewith;

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Bihar in the forty eighth year of the Republic of India as follows:
