**Section 33 - Release, on Recognizance, by Order of High Court, of Prisoner Recommended for Pardon**

<sup>1</sup>[Any High Court] may, in any case in which it has recommended to<sup>2</sup>[Government] the granting of a free pardon to any prisoner, permit him to be at liberty on his own recognizance.
