### Section 4 - Appointment of Officers of Customs

<sup>1</sup>[Appointment of officers of customs

(1) The<sup>2</sup>[ Board] may appoint such persons as it thinks fit to be officers of customs.

(2) Without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (1), the<sup>3</sup>[ Board may authorise a Chief Commissioner of Customs or, a Commissioner of Customs or] a<sup>4</sup>[ Joint or Assistant Commissioner of Customs or Deputy Commissioner of Customs] to appoint officers of customs below the rank of Assistant Commissioner of Customs or Deputy Commissioner of Customs.]
