

Elephants Prevention Act,1879

Section 6 - Power of State Government to Declare What Are Main Roads and Canals, and to Make Rules as to Licences

The State Government may from time to time [The words " subject to the control of the G.G.in C." repealed by Act 38 of 1920, section 2 and Schedule I.] declare what shall be deemed to be main public roads and canals within the meaning of this Act, and make rules consistent with this Act for regulating

- (a) the grant and renewal of licenses under this Act,
- (b) the fees (if any) in money, tusks or captured elephants to be charged on such grant and renewal;
- (c) the time during which such licenses shall continue in force.
- (d) the conditions (if any) on which they shall be granted.

All such declarations and rules shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall thereupon have the force of law.
