

**Forest Act, 1963**

**Section 90 - Felling, Conversion or Removal of Catechu Trees by the Forest or Revenue Department or by a Person**

---

The felling, conversion or removal of catechu trees and timber or manufacture of catch shall not be effected by any person, other than the following, namely:-

(1) by the officers of the Forest and Revenue Departments of the State Government authorised in this behalf by the State Government either by a general or special order; or

(2) by a person holding a permit granted by the<sup>1</sup>[Deputy Conservator of Forest]
