Section 8C - Power of Central Government to Make Rules for Securing Safe Custody and Re-delivery of Nclaimed Property

1[Subject to the provisions of section 14, the Central Government] may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules which may provide for securing the safe custody and re delivery of any property which, while not in proper custody is found on any aerodrome or in any aircraft on any aerodrome and any such rules may, in particular, provide for -

- (a) the payment of charges in respect of any such property before it is re-delivered to the person entitled there to and:
- (b) the disposal of any such property in cases where the same is not re-delivered to the person entitled thereto before the expiration of such period as may be specified therein.
