

**Pensions Act, 1871**

**Section 13 - Reward to Informers**

---

Whoever proves to the satisfaction of the<sup>1</sup>[appropriate Government] that any pension is fraudulently or unduly received by the person enjoying the benefit thereof, shall be entitled to a reward equivalent to the amount of such pension for the period of six months.
