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Apprentices Act, 1961

Section 1 - Short title, extent, commencement and application.—

THE APPRENTICES ACT, 1961 ACTNO.52 OF 1961 [12th December, 1961.]An Act to provide for the regulation and control of training of apprentices^{1***} and for matters connected therewith. BE it enacted by Parliament in the Twelfth Year of the Republic of India as follows: CHAPTER ISection 1 - PRELIMINARY
1) This Act may be called theApprentices Act,

(3) It shall come into force on such date³ as the Central Government may, by notification in theOfficial Gazette, appoint; and different dates may be appointed for different States. (4) The provisions of this Act shall not apply to (a) any area or to any industry in any area unless the Central Government by notification in the Official Gazette specifies that area or industry as an area or industry to which the said provisions shall apply with effect from such date as may be mentioned in the notification; 4 * * * ** 5 [(c) any such special apprenticeship scheme for imparting training to apprentices as may be notified by the Central Government in the Official Gazette.]
