Section 178A - SANCTION FOR BUILDING - No person shall erect or re-erect a building on any land in a cantonment

a) in an area, other than the civil area, except with the previous sanction of the Board; (b) in a civil area, except with the previous sanction of the Executive Officer, nor otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter and of the rules and bye-laws made under this Act relating to the erection and re-erection of building.] Act 15 of 1983, Clause 100.-This clause seeks to substitute a new section for section 178A of the Act to provide that for the sanction of building plans a notice by an individual intending to erect or re-erect a building in the civil area should be given to the Executive Officer. In the remaining area of the cantonment, however, the building application will be submitted to the Board as usual. This is considered necessary to alleviate the hardship of the people intending t
