Section 218 - CONTROL OVER SOURCES OF PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY

1) Thea[Board] may, with the previous sanction of theb[Central Government], by public notice, declare any lake, stream, spring, well, tank, reservoir or other source, whether within or without the limits of the cantonment (other than a source of water-supply under the control of theb [Military Engineer] Services or the Public Works Department) from which water is or may be made available for the use of the public in the cantonment to be a source of public water-supply. (2) Every such source shall be under the control of thea[Board].
