

Cantonments Act, 1924

Section 41 - Minutes

(1) Minutes of the proceedings of each meeting shall be recorded in a book and shall be signed by¹ [the person presiding over the meeting] before the close of the meeting and shall, at such times and in such place as may be fixed by the Board, be open to inspection free of charge by any inhabitant of the cantonment.

(2) Copies of the minutes shall, as soon as possible after each meeting, be forwarded for information to²[the Officer Commanding-in-Chief, the Command],¹[the Officer Commanding the Area, the Officer Commanding the sub-area, the District Magistrate and the Defence Estates Officer and in cantonments where Navy or Air Force stations are located, copies of the minutes shall be forwarded for information to the Command Headquarters of the Navy or, as the case may be, the Air Force].
