

Cantonments Act, 1924

Section 49 - Power to Require Execution of Work, Etc

If, on receipt of any information or report obtained¹[under section 46 or section 47] or section 48, the²[Central Government or the Officer Commanding-in-chief, the Command,] is of opinion-

(a) that any duty imposed on a³[Board] by or under this Act has not been performed or has been performed in an imperfect, inefficient or unsuitable manner, or

(b) that adequate financial provision has not been made for the performance of any such duty,

⁴[it or] he may⁵[* * *] direct the⁶[Board], within such period as⁴[it or] he thinks fit, to make arrangements to⁴[its or] his satisfaction for the proper performance of the duty, or, as the case may be, to make financial provision to⁴[its or] his satisfaction for the performance of the duty:

provided that, unless in the opinion of the⁷[Central Government or the Officer Commanding-in-Chief, the Command, as the case may be,] the immediate execution of such order is necessary,⁴[it or] he shall, before making any direction under this section, give the⁶[Board] an opportunity of showing cause why such direction should not be made.
