Section 2A - Provisions as to companies registered in Burma or Aden before separation from India: [Notwithstanding anything in the

a) shall be deemed for the purposes of this Act to be a company registered and incorporated outside British India, and (b) shall not, unless the subject-matter or context so requires, be included in the expressions "company", "existing company", "public company", and "private company": Provided that- (i) for the purposes of (section 277) of this Act such a company shall, for a period of six months from the separation, be deemed to be a company incorporated and registered in British India; (ii) the separation of Burma and Aden from India shall not render valid any mortgage or charge which, immediately before that date, was void against [the liquidator or creditors of such a company.]
