SECTION 10: POWER TO HOLD INQUESTS ON BODIES WITHIN LOCAL LIMITS WHEREVER CAUSE OF DEATH OCCURRED - Whenever an inquest ought to be holden on any body lying dead within the local limits of the jurisdiction of any Coroner, he shall hold such inquest, whether or not the cause of death arose within his jurisdiction.
