

Consumer Protection Act, 1986

Section 4 - The Central Consumer Protection Council

(1) 1 [The Central Government shall], by notification 2 , establish with effect from such date as it may specify in such notification, a Council to be known as the Central Consumer Protection Council (hereinafter referred to as the Central Council).

(2) The Central Council shall consist of the following members, namely:---

(a) the Minister in charge of the 3 [consumer affairs] in the Central Government, who shall be its Chairman, and

(b) such number of other official or non-official members representing such interests as may be prescribed.
