Indian Emigration Act, 1922

Section 6 - APPOINTMENT OF MEDICAL INSPECTORS

1) The 19 [Central Government] may appoint one or more Medical Inspectors of 20 [Emigrants at any port or airport] from which emigration is lawful or at any other place, and, where more than one are appointed, may apportion their respective duties, (2) Every Medical Inspector of Emigrants shall be a public servant within the meaning of the Indian Penal Code.
