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Indian Emigration Act, 1922

Section 10 - COUNTRIES TO-WHICH EMIGRATION OF UNSKILLED WORKERS IS LAWFUL

1) Emigration, for the purpose of unskilled work, shall not be lawful except to such countries and on such terms and conditions as the Central Government, by notification a in the Official Gazette, may specify in this behalf, (2) No notification shall be made under sub-section (1) unless it has been laid in draft before 28 [*****] 29 [Parliament] and has been approved by a resolution of 30 [Parliament], either without modification or addition, or with modifications and additions to which 31 [Parliament] agrees], but, upon such approval being given, the notification may be issued in the form in which it has been so approved.
