Navy Act, 1957

Section 55C - LOW FLYING AND ANNOYANCE BY FLYING Every person subject to naval law being the pilot of an aircraft of the Indian Navy,

a) files it at a height less than the minimum height authorised by his commanding officer or appropriate service authority except while taking off or landing; or (b) files it so as to cause or likely to cause unnecessary annoyance to any person, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or such other punishment as is hereinafter mentioned.]
