

Petroleum Act, 1934

Section 15 - Standard Test Apparatus

1) A standard apparatus for determining the 3 (a) [a] Substituted for 'flashing-point' by the Petroleum (Amendment) Act, 1970 (24 of 1970), S. 11 (29-5-1970). [flash-point] of petroleum shall be deposited with an officer to be appointed in this behalf by the 3 (b) [b] Substituted for the words "Governor-General in Council" and "Gazette of India" respectively by A.O., 1937. [Central Government], by notification in the 3 (b) [b] Substituted for the words "Governor-General in Council" and "Gazette of India" respectively by A.O., 1937. [Official Gazette]. (2) Such apparatus shall be engraved with the words "Standard Test Apparatus", and shall be verified and corrected from time to time and replaced when necessary in accordance with rules made under (section 21) . (3) The Standard Test Apparatus shall, on payment of the prescribed-fee, be open to inspection at all reasonable times by any person wishing to inspect it.
