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**Post Office Act, 1898**

**Section 28 - Registration of postal articles** The sender of a postal article may, subject to the other provisions of this Act, have

a) [a] Substituted for the words "Governor-General in Council" and for the words "Gazette of India" by A.O., 1937. [Central Government] may, by notification in the 3 (a) [a] Substituted for the words "Governor-General in Council" and for the words "Gazette of India" by A.O., 1937. [Official Gazette], direct that, in addition to any postage chargeable under this Act, such further fee as may be fixed by the notification shall be paid on account of the registration of postal articles.
