**Section 42 - Allowance of gratuities for conveyance of postal articles by ships other than mailships The

[India] as aforesaid shall, if he receives on board a mail bag for conveyance, be entitled to demand and obtain immediately the amount of the gratuity payable under this section in respect of the mail bag and its contents
