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Post Office Act, 1898

Section 74 - General power to make rules and provisions as to rules under Act

1) In addition to the powers hereinbefore conferred, the 3 (a) [a] Substituted tor the words 'Governor-General in Council' and for the words "Gazette of India" by A.O., 1937. [Central Government] may make rules to carry out any of the purposes and objects of this Act. (2) In making any rule under this Act. the 3 (a) [a] Substituted tor the words 'Governor-General in Council' and for the words "Gazette of India" by A.O., 1937. [Central Government] may direct that a breach of it shall be punishable with fine which may extend to fifty rupees. (3) All rules made by the 3 (a) [a] Substituted tor the words 'Governor-General in Council' and for the words "Gazette of India" by A.O., 1937. [Central Government] under this Act shall be published in the 3 (a) [a] Substituted tor the words 'Governor-General in Council' and for the words "Gazette of India" by A.O., 1937. [Official Gazette] and, on such publication, shall have effect as if enacted by this Act.
