

Inflammable Substances Act, 1952

Section 3 - Declaration of Certain Substances to Be Dangerously Inflammable

The liquids and other substances hereinafter mentioned, namely:-

- (1) acetone,
- (2) calcium phosphide,
- (3) carbide of calcium,
- (4) cinematograph films having a nitro-cellulose base,
- (5) ethyl alcohol,
- (6) methyl alcohol,
- (7) wood naphtha,

are hereby declared to be dangerously inflammable.
