Section 6 - POWER TO SPECIFY MINIMUM LIMITS OF GERMINATION AND PURITY, ETC
The Central Government may, after consultation with the

a) the minimum limits of germination and purity with respect to any seed of any notified kind or variety; (b) the marker label to indicate that such seed conforms to the minimum limits of germination and purity specified. under clause (a) and the particulars which such mark or label may contain "Clause 6 (original clause 7).- The Committee are of opinion that the provisions relating to specification of minimum standards of pedigree, crop purity and seed quality of foundation seed; etc., which are matter of detail, need not be made in the Bill. The clause has been amended for the purposes." - J.C.R.
