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Vaccination Act, 1880

Section 6 - PROHIBITION OF INOCULATION In any local area to which the provisions of this Act apply, inoculation shall be prohibited

SECTION 06: PROHIBITION OF INOCULATION In any local area to which the provisions of this Act apply, inoculation shall be prohibited and Inoculated persons not to enter, without certificate, local area subject to Act no person who has undergone inoculation shall enter such area before the lapse of forty days from the date of the operation, without a certificate from a medical practitioner of such class as the State Government may from time to time by written order authorize to grant such certificates, stating that such person is no longer likely to produce small-pox by contact or near approach.
