Section 3 - Employment of Police Officers Beyond the State to Which They Belong

Notwithstanding anything in any of the Acts mentioned or referred to in the last foregoing section, but subject to any order which the Central Government may make in this behalf, a member of the {Subs.by the A.O.1937, for "police-establishment "}. [police forcer of any {Subs., ibid., for "Presidency, Province or place"}.] [State] may discharge the functions of police-officer in any part of {Subs.by the A.O.1948, for "British India beyond the limits of the Province"}. [any other State] and shall.while s discharging such functions, be deemed to be a member of the {Subs.by the A.O.1937 for "that establishment"}.
