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Sarais Act, 1867

Section 14 - Penalty for Infringing Act or Regulations

If the keeper of a sar offend against any of the provisions of this Act or any of the regulations made in pursuance of this Act, he shall for every such offence be liable on conviction before any Magistrate to a penalty not exceeding twenty rupees, and to a further penalty not exceeding one rupee a day for every day during which the offence continues :

Provided always that this Act shall not exempt any person from any penalty or other liability to which he may be subject, irrespective of this Act.

All penalties imposed under this Act may be recovered in the same manner as fines may be recovered under { See now sections 386, 387 and 389 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act 5 of 1898).}section 61 (25 of 1861) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
