## **Apprentices Act, 1961**

### **Chapter 11 - Obligation of employers**

Without prejudice to the other provisions of this Act, every employer shall have the following obligations in relation to an apprentice, namely-(a) to provide the apprentice with the training in his trade in accordance with the provisions of this Act, and the rules made thereunder;(b) if the employer is not himself qualified in the trade, to ensure that a person (Subs. by Act 27 of 1973.) [who possesses the prescribed qualifications] is placed in charge of the training of the apprentice; [ \* \* \* ] (Omitted by Act 4 of 1997)(Ins. by Act 4 of 1997.) [(bb) to provide adequate instructional staff, possessing such qualifications as may be prescribed, for imparting practical and theoretical training and facilities for trade test of apprentices; and ](c) to carry out his obligations under the contract of apprenticeship.
