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Poisons Act, 1919

Section 3 - Power to Prohibit Importation into the States of Any Poison Except Under Licence

The Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, prohibit, except under and in accordance with the conditions of a licence, the importation into ¹[India] {Ins.by the A.O.1937}[across any customs frontier {For definition of the customs frontiers of India, see Gazette of India, 1955, Pt.II, Sec.3, P.1521} defined by the Central Government] of any specified poison, and may by rule regulate the grant of licences.
