Section 5 - Indorsements to Be Made on Security Itself

Notwithstanding anything in section 15 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, (26 of 1881.) no indorsement of a Government promissory note shall be valid unless made by the signature of the holder inscribed on the back of the security itself.
