

Cess Act, 1880

Section 2 - Extent This Act shall take effect at once in every district and part of a district in which Bengal Act 10 of 1871

an Act to provide for local rating for the construction and maintenance of roads and other means of communication) and Bengal Act 2 of 1877 (an Act to provide for the levy of a cess for the construction, charges and maintenance of provincial public works) may be in force on the date of the commencement of this Act.
