

Howrah Improvement Act, 1956

Section 19 - Subject to the rules made under section 145 in this behalf, every

Trustee (other than the Chairman) and every person associated with the Board under section 16 shall be entitled to receive a fee of '[Rupees]', and every member of a Committee a fee of '[twenty-five rupees]', for attending a meeting of the Board or a Committee at which business is transacted: Provided (that a person who is a salaried servant of the State or the Central Government shall not be entitled to receive any fee as aforesaid. Trustees and members of (a) has, directly or indirectly, by himself or by any partner, partner, partner or any Committee, employer or employee, any such share or interest as is1101 to be described in sub-section (2) of section 5, in respect of any property in possession, in which they (6) has acted professionally, in relation to any matter, on behalf of any person having [herein any such share or interest as aforesaid, shall not vote or take any other part in any proceeding of the Board or any Committee relating to such matter. (2) If any Trustee, or any person associated with the Board under section 16, or any other member of a Committee appointed under this Act, has, directly or indirectly, any beneficial interest in any land situated in an area comprised in any improvement scheme framed under this Act, or in an area in which it is proposed to acquire land for any of the purposes of this Act, - (i) he shall, before taking part in any proceeding at a meeting of the Board or any Committee relating to such area, inform the person presiding at the meeting of the nature of such interest, (ii) he shall not vote at any meeting of the Board or any Committee upon any resolution or question relating to such land, and (iii) he shall not take any other part in any proceeding at a meeting of the Board or any Committee relating to such area if the person presiding at the meeting considers it inexpedient that he should do so. The Board may, on behalf of any person or the State Government, execute any work or render any service, not being a work executed or service which is inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, in any common works or area to which this Act applies on such terms and conditions as may be determined upon between the Board and such person or the State Government, certain services. as the case may be: Provided that when any work is executed or any service is rendered on behalf of any person, no such work shall be executed or rendered except with the previous sanction of the State Government.
