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Howrah Improvement Act, 1956

Section 41 - No street laid out or altered by the Board shall be of less width than

than- (a) forty feet, if it is to be intended for carriage traffic, or (b) twenty feet, if it is to be intended for foot traffic only: Provided as follows:- (i) the width of an existing street need not be increased to the minimum required by this section, if the Board consider it impracticable to do so; (ii) nothing in this section shall be deemed to prevent the Board from laying out service passages for sanitary purposes of any width less than twenty feet
