

Howrah Improvement Act, 1956

Section 45 - (I) When any i m p r o v c m c n t scheme has been framed, t h e B o d publiion and Inns

shall prepare a notice stating- (a) the fact that the scheme has been framed, (b) the boundaries of the area comprised in the scheme, and (c) the place at which particulars of the scheme, a map of the area comprised in the scheme, and a statement of the land documents which it is proposed to acquire and of the land in regard to the application, which it is proposed to recover a betterment fee, may be seen at reasonable hours. (2) The Board shall- (i) cause the said notice to be published weekly for three consecutive weeks in the Official Gazette and in local newspapers, with a statement of the period within which objections will be received, and (ii) send a copy of the notice to the [Mayor] to the Chairman or any other Municipal officer under the Bengal Municipal Act, 1932, in which, and to the General Manager of the Calcutta Metropolitan Water and Sanitation Authority and to the Chief Executive Officer of the Calcutta Metropolitan Development Authority under whose jurisdiction, any portion of the area comprised in the scheme is situated. (3) The Chairman shall cause copies of all documents referred to in clause (c) of sub-section (1) to be delivered to any applicant on payment of such fee as may be prescribed by rule made under section
