Section 58 - Whenever the Board allow any street vested in them to be used for any other purpose

1923. (1) The provisions of the Bengal Municipal Act, 1932, as in force in any Municipality of Bengal, and the provisions of the Calcutta Municipal Act, 1923, as extended to the Howrah Municipal Corporation, and the corresponding provisions or rules, if any, made under the Bengal Municipal Act, 1932, shall not apply when any drain, pavement or surface referred to in the said rules is opened or broken up by the Board or when any public sewer is under construction by the Board. (2) The Board shall, as far as practicable, keep the street in good repair and do all things necessary for the safety and convenience of persons using it, and (b) they shall cause the street to be widened, if they consider it necessary to do so for the public convenience.
