

Howrah Improvement Act, 1956

Section 65 - (1) When the Board are of opinion- hlu~icipal

(a) that any street laid out or altered by them has been duly constructed, paved, metalled, nagged, channelled, sewered and illuminated in the manner provided in the plan sanctioned by the Local Government under section 50, the Local Board may (b) that such lamps, lamp-posts or other apparatus as are required or necessary for the lighting of such street have been provided, and (c) that water and other sanitary conveniences ordinarily provided by the Local Board in a municipality have been duly provided in such public street, in which case they shall report to the Commissioners of the Howrah Municipal Corporation or any Municipality of Howrah, as the case may be, within the month from the date of receipt of such report, after such inquiry as they think fit to make, either to declare the street to be a public street by written notice affixed in some conspicuous position in such street, "The words 'bribe' 8 ~ 1 l y Municipality. = the case may be." were first inserted in section 65, by s. 30 of the Howrah Improvement Act (Amendment) Act, 1983 (IV of 1983, Act XLIII of 1983). Thereafter the words within the first bracket were substituted for the word "Commissioners of the Howrah Municipal Corporation or the Bally Municipality." by s. 26(n) of the Howrah Improvement Act (Amendment) Act, 1995 (XXV of 1995).
