Section 91 - Nothing in the Calcutta Trika Tenancy Act, 1949, or in the West

1972. Housing Board constituted under the West Bengal Housing Board Act, 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the Housing Board), requires any land vested in or acquired by the Board under this Act, for carrying out any of the purposes of the Act under which the Authority or the Housing Board, as the case may be, was constituted, the Authority or the Housing Board, as the case may be, may ask the Board to let on hire, lease, sell, exchange or otherwise dispose of such land to itself and the Board shall comply with such demand and within the transfer possession of such land in favour of the Authority or the Housing Board, as the case may be. (4) The amount of consideration at which any land shall be let on hire, sold, exchanged or otherwise disposed of under sub-section (3) shall be such as may be agreed between the Authority or the Housing Board, as the case may be, and the Board, and if they fail to reach an agreement, the parties or any of them shall refer the matter to the State Government and the decision of the State Government.
