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## Howrah Improvement Act, 1956

### Section 145 - (1) It shall be the duty of the Board to remedy any defect or

defects or irregularities which may be pointed out by the auditor. (2) If there is a difference of opinion between the Board and the auditor, or if the Board do not remedy any defect or irregularity within a period considered by the auditor to be reasonable, the matters shall be referred to the State Government within such time and in such form as may be prescribed by the Government. (3) If within any period fixed by an order made by the State Government under sub-section (2), the Board fail to comply with such order, the State Government may direct the Chairman to comply with the order and the cost of such order shall be in charge on the revenue account of the Board.
