

CONVERTS' MARRIAGE DISSOLUTION ACT, 1866

Section 34 - Saving of Roman Catholic marriages

Nothing contained in this Act {The words and figures "or in Acts No section XXV of 1864 and V of 1865" rep. by Act 16 of 1874, section 1 and Schedule} shall be taken to render invalid any marriage of a {The word "Native" omitted by the A.O.1950.} convert to Roman Catholicism if celebrated in accordance with the rules, rites, ceremonies and customs of the Roman Catholic Church {The words "and no Clergyman of such Church shall be liable to any suit or penalty under the provisions of either of the two Acts last herein mentioned, for solemnizing any such marriage rep. by Act 16 of Schedule [NOTE: The Act does not extend to the State of Manipur, vice Act 30 of 1950, section 3 (2A) and Schedule (Part A), as amended by Act 68 of 1956, section 2]}
