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The INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ACT, 2000

Section 85B - (1) In any proceedings involving a secure electronic record, the Court shall presume unless contrary is proved, that

(2) In any proceedings, involving secure digital signature, the Court shall presume unless the contrary is proved that (a) the secure digital signature is affixed by subscriber with the intention of signing or approving the electronic record; (b) except in the case of a secure electronic record or a secure digital signature, nothing in this section shall create any presumption relating to authenticity and integrity of the electronic record or any digital signature.
