

**Official Languages Act, 1963**

**Section 5 - Authorised Hindi Translation of Central Acts, Etc**

---

(1) A translation in Hindi published under the authority of the President in the Official Gazette on and after the appointed day,--

(a) of any Central Act or of any Ordinance promulgated by the President, or

(b) of any order, regulation or bye-law issued under the Constitution or under any Central Act, shall be deemed to be the authoritative text thereof in Hindi.

(2) As from the appointed day<sup>1</sup> the authoritative text in the English language of all Bills to be introduced or amendments thereto be moved in either House of Parliament shall be accompanied by a translation of the same in Hindi authorised in such manner as may be prescribed by rules made under this Act.
