Heard learned counsel for the parties.

It reveals from the F.I.R. that petitioners have sold Gair Mazaru land to the informant company and realised money. This fact was detected when the company applied for mutation of the land purchased from these petitioners.

It is submitted that petitioners have no intention to cheat the informant.

As a matter of fact, the rent receipt was being issued for the said land in the name of their father and they had been coming in possession over the land in question since from 1961. Only because the mutation has been refused, petitioners cannot be held liable for the offence of cheating.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering facts and circumstances as well as detention of petitioners in custody, they are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the
