ORDER Petitioner is an accused in Crime No.1337 of 2012 of Pathanamthitta Police Station, who is alleged to have committed offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 148, 353, 308, 294(b) read with Section 149 I.P.C. and Section 3(1) of the P.D.P.P. Act. Though the petitioner claims to be innocent, that claim does not appear to be correct on a perusal of the CD made available for perusal by the learned Public Prosecutor.

2. Considering the nature of the offence said to have been committed by the petitioner, it is felt that this is not a fit case where the extraordinary jurisdiction needs to be exercised in favour of the petitioner. Therefore, this application is dismissed. However, if the petitioner is so advised, he may surrender before the Investigating Officer on or before B.A.8824/2012

28. 12.2012, who after interrogation, shall produce him before the JFCM Court concerned, which court, on an application for bail being moved by the petitioner, shall dispose of the same in accordance with law. P. BHAVADASAN, JUDGE sb.

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
