----- DATED THIS THE 30th DAY OF JANUARY, 2013 ORDER The petitioner is involved in a criminal case alleging offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. The case was posted to 29.10.2011 for appearance and on that day, the petitioner could not appear and a non-bailable warrant has been ordered against the petitioner. The case is now pending in the long pending register as L.P.C.No.126/11. It is stated that the petitioner is working as a 'Poojari' in a temple at Karnataka State and since he was not in station, he could not appear before court and the case was posted for appearance. The prayer is only to permit the petitioner to surrender before the court and to file an application for bail.

2. The petitioner will surrender before the court below within ten days and will file an application for bail, which will be duly considered by the court, preferably on the same date of surrender.
