@ Rakesh Singh is moved by Sri B.M. Tripathy, Sr. Advocate and opposed by Sri
Amitabh, learned Additional P.P. This is a case under sections
147,149,323,307,448,379 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code. So far offence under
section 307 of the IPC is concerned, there is general and omnibus allegations
against all the accused persons. It is submitted that informant had received no
injury, thus he has not been sent for medical examination. So far, the allegation of
snatching of chain and taking away sum of Rs. 49,000/- is concerned, it is
submitted that the same has been falsely alleged . It is submitted that on 3.3.2013
informant had issued a cheque in favour of petitioner towards freight of vehicle,
taken on rent. It is submitted that when petitioner presented said cheque for
encashment, the same has been dishonoured. It is submitted that when petitioner
made complaint about the same, present case has been filed. Considering the

aforesaid facts and circumstance and also taking into account that co-accused Rakesh Agrawal @ Rakesh Prasad has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 14.5.2013 in ABA No. 1563 of 2013, I allow this application and direct the petitioner to surrender in the court below by 13.09.2013 and in that event the court below is directed to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Jamshedpur in connection with Mango (Olidih) P.S. Case No. 110 of 2013 (G.R. No. 742 of 2013) , subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. (Prashant Kumar,J.) Sharda/-

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
